SUBJECT: APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY (U338E) FOR APPROVAL OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY ROLLING PORTFOLIO BUSINESS PLAN AND RELATED MATTERS. CCE-DR01

QUESTION 18

In the joint February 23, 2015 Advice Letter on the WE&T Program Implementation Plan Addendum (PG&E Advice 3567-G/4592-E; SDG&E Advice 3179-E; SCE Advice 3179-E; SoCalGas Advice 4765-G), the IOUs stated that they would adopt a responsible contractor policy for contractors that work directly with the IOUs.⁸

- (a) Was a responsible contractor policy adopted for contractors that work directly with the IOUs?
- (b) If yes, please provide a copy of the policy and identify what programs are required to comply with this policy.
- (c) If no, please provide any studies, reports, memorandums, data or other documents describing the steps taken to comply with this commitment.

ANSWER 18

As stated in the Joint February 23, 2015 Advice Letter PG&E Partially adopted this recommendation proposing the following:

Revised Recommendation 1.1 - Adopt a responsible contractor policy for use across all resource programs where contractors work directly with the IOU.

1.1.1 Require that all ratepayer-subsidized projects meet pre-established, clearly defined minimum standards relating to contractor responsibility, including: all applicable licenses, bonding and insurance (including workers' compensation), wage and labor law compliance, OSHA compliance, and permitting that includes passing code inspections.

(a) Was a responsible contractor policy adopted for contractors that work directly with the IOUs?

Yes, the revised recommendation was adopted as written.

(b) If yes, please provide a copy of the policy and identify what programs are required to comply with this policy.

PG&E directs CEE to attachments provided in response to Question 16 for documentation supporting this policy. Such documents include, among others, applications for deemed and custom projects, guidelines and an application for joining the Trade Professionals Alliance, and documentation requiring contractors installing or overseeing the installation of HVAC replacements to providing permitting information and proof of permit closure. PG&E also directs CEE to learn more about how these policies are included in programs by reviewing program manuals on CEDARS. To access the manuals:

In addition, Senate Bill 350 requires the Energy Commission to establish a responsible contractor policy for energy efficiency retrofits. PG&E is collaborating with stakeholders and consultants to inform the development of new policies in accordance with Senate Bill 350.
