Department of Energy (DOE) Request for Information (RFI) on Executive Order 13771

Provide all documents (draft and final) and all emails relating to DOE Rulemaking DOE_FRDOC_0001-3375, DOE's RFI pertaining to its implementation of Executive Order 13771 Reducing Regulation and Controlling Regulatory Costs.

Response to Question 01:

SCE objects to this request under Rule 10.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure on the grounds that the burden, expense and intrusiveness of this request outweighs the likelihood that the information sought will lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. SCE also objects to this request to the extent it seeks production of information that is not relevant to the EE Business Plan Applications submitted in proceeding A.17-01-013 et al. or issues/scope in the proceeding. Subject to and without waiving the foregoing objection, SCE respond as follows:

Southern California Edison (SCE) has attached, to the best of its knowledge, all emails in its possession relating to DOE Rulemaking DOE_FRDOC_0001-3375. As the statewide lead for Federal Standards, it is common practice for Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) to draft, update, and finalize DOE comment letters, and facilitate collaboration and coordination among the California IOUs¹ and the California Energy Commission (CEC). This RFI was no exception, and therefore, SCE defers to PG&E's response(s) to this data request to the extent PG&E (as a statewide lead) may have a more comprehensive collection of emails from the CA IOUs and CEC in developing and finalizing the comment letter for this DOE rulemaking.
