Perhaps we can replace our proposal of 0 gpm with a statement similar to this from CEC's presentation:

"Staff is considering reducing the tub spout diverter leakage rate below 0.01 gpm when new and below 0.05 gpm after 15,000 cycles of diverting."

I want to have a primary proposed code language change such as that since it will:

- contain the scope of this two month project
- focus on a straight forward code change in alignment with CEC goals
- yield cost effective savings

The recommendation may include to not do anything, or to do something different than the proposed changes. As is, the research would be biased with a particular outcome desired.
