CEER Program Overview

- Addresses Gaps in 3P Portfolio: Targets all sectors and captures project savings not eligible under current program offerings
- Captures Stranded Customers: Intended to also support customers who have commenced with installations but may be determined ineligible under program design or in instances where 3P contracts have terminated prematurely
- Reintroduces Downstream Incentives: Calculated and Deemed offerings
- In-House Implementation: Implemented by SCE
- Comprehensive Sector Coverage: Ensures no customer opportunities are left unaddressed
- Market Support Program: Will not endeavor to achieve set energy savings goals, but instead will make a customer's opportunity whole

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Program Description

- Comprehensive Energy Efficiency Resource (CEER) program helps address gaps in SCE's primarily Third-Party (3P) driven portfolio
- Allows for the installation and claiming of project savings that may not otherwise be eligible under current program offerings
- There will be energy efficiency opportunities that may require a simpler and more direct interim approach, which is not covered by the current 3P program designs that could be addressed by CEER
- A primary objective of this program is to ensure that "stranded" customer opportunities are captured

Program Delivery and Customer Services

- The program will offer Custom and Deemed measures to augment 3P offerings when stranded opportunities are identified by an SCE 3P implementer(s)
- The CEER program is a market support program and spans all Sectors, e.g., Agricultural, Commercial, Industrial, Public Sector, Cross Cutting, and Residential
- As a supplement to SCE's 3P programs, opportunity leads will come from various sources like 3P implementers and non-IOU Program Administrators (PAs)
- The program will not endeavor to achieve set energy savings goals, but instead will make a customer's opportunity whole
- This program may also serve to cover gaps while new 3P programs are under solicitation or after they exit the market

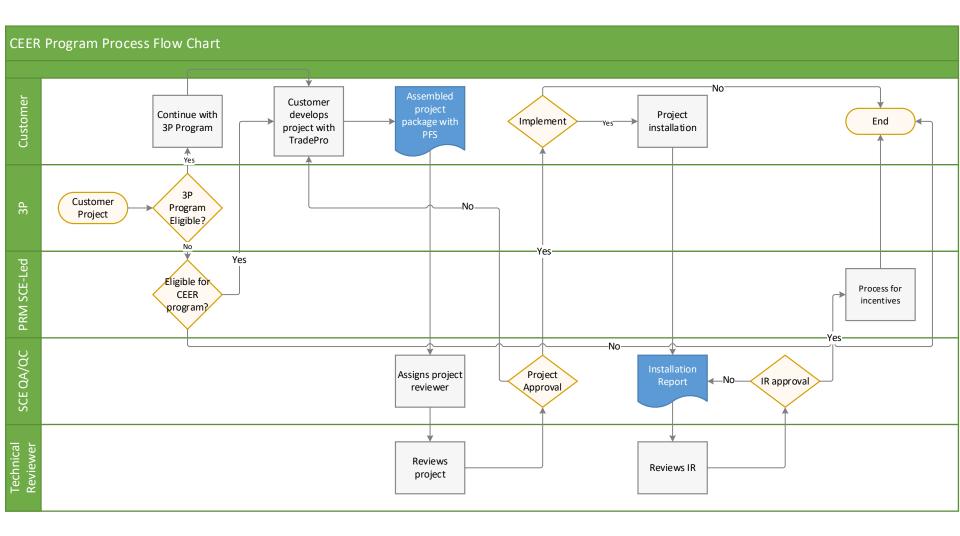
