





Scope of Regional Energy Networks (RENs)

(EE Policy Manual v6, p.20-21)

- 1. Activities that utilities or CCA program administrators cannot or do not intend to undertake.
- 2. Pilot activities where there is no current utility or CCA program offering, and where there is potential for scalability to a broader geographic reach, if successful.
- 3. Activities serving hard-to-reach markets, whether or not there is another utility or CCA program that may overlap.

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Illustrative Questions

- 1. Given all the technical and policy aspects, what is the strategic vision of the PA moving forward?

- 4. If there are technical issues, how could we bring in the <u>California Technical Forum</u>?

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Key Themes

- Significant savings anticipated in 2024 Q3/4
- Fuel substitution showing as negative savings > necessitates look at bill impacts
- EE with Electrification
- Ag/Industrial challenges
- Staff turnover
- Public sector challenges (anticipating more cuts to local gov't)
- SDG&E role change proposal and off-cycle Business Plan App

Discussion - Facilitator Summary of Segmentation Justification & Program Overlap

Segmentation

- Exercise seemed redundant and burdensome
- Repeat this exercise?
 - More appropriate venues: information already in CEDARS, Biz Plan applications, and Annual Reports

Overlap

- Op32 efforts identified a few programs with overlap or that are substantially similar
- PAs already have protocols for customer verification and to prevent double dipping
- Program overlap can actually be beneficial for serving hard-to-reach customers and meeting market needs (noted by 1 PA)
- Continued analysis needs to be done to address the potential for duplicative incentives and TSB claims for a single measure
- Repeat this exercise?
 - More appropriate venues: JCMs, Portfolio Administrator Sector Coordination (PASC)
 - Some PAs suggest additional analysis is needed (e.g. measure level assessments, market channel review)
